With Sue Redfern MBE, former international cricket player turned umpire**

This is your opportunity to join us at recently refurbished The Lost and Found restaurant for a unique private dining experience and to hear from WiBA's 2018 Woman of Distinction, Sue Redfern MBE. Every year, WiBA celebrates the achievements of a woman of distinction who has broken through boundaries to succeed in a traditionally male-dominated environment.

Cricket is in the blood, the heartbeat of Sue, from family passion through to a continued life within the boundaries of cricket. At the tender age of 13 she started playing senior women's cricket. This led to her future career in cricket administration and also helped her become, at the time the youngest ever to represent England (beaten 2 years later by Charlotte Edwards MBE). Now retired from playing, Sue continues to work full time in cricket administration helping grassroots cricket clubs, whilst also being a semi-professional cricket umpire within the performance pathways (both men and women) in England. She continues to officiate internationally through the International Cricket Councils Development Panel (male and female). Sue is the first female across the world to both play and umpire in cricket World Cups (1997 and 2017). She was appointed an MBE in the recent Queens Birthday honours in June for her services to women's cricket in the UK and beyond.

Our lunch will be held in the private dining area of one of Birmingham's most striking venues, The Lost and Found. Known as the Secret Room, the entrance to the private dining area can be found hidden behind a bookcase! With stunning interiors inspired by the Victorian Era and housed within a Grade II listed building, the botanical theme is based on fictional Victorian professor and explorer Hettie G. Watson.

Join us at 12pm for a welcome drink, followed by a delicious 2 course meal and a glass of wine or soft drink. We will finish at 2.15pm allowing you to return to work. At just £29 for members at £35 for guests, we hope you can join us with your colleagues, clients, and friends or on your own for what promises to be a fascinating speaker lunch in a fabulous City Centre venue.
